

# RULES & REGULATIONS

## 1. GAMEPLAY

- Teams are guaranteed a minimum of 4 games in a Preliminary Series format leading up to the Semi-Final and Final Games on Sunday.
- During the Preliminary Series, Teams will be given 2 points for a win, and 1 for a tie.
- There will be no overtime in Preliminary Series games.

## 2. GAME SCHEDULING

- At least 3 hours must lapse between games in any series (the end of the 1st game and start of 2nd game for each team).
- No games are to be scheduled before 8:00 a.m. or after 9:00 p.m. For U11, the Preliminary Series games must be ended by 8:45 p.m.
- Teams will not play more than two games per day.

## 3. SWEATERS

- Home Teams should wear light-coloured sweaters and socks, and visiting Teams should wear dark-coloured sweaters and socks.
- In case of a sweaters conflict, the team with two sets of sweaters will wear the opposite colour, or the Host will provide the extra sweaters.

## 4. All games will be played as follows:

	Stop Time (3 Periods)	Scheduling Time
U11   U13/U15/U18 House League	13 minute stop time	1 hour & 15 minutes
U13	14 minute stop time	1 hour & 25 minutes
U15 & U18	15 minute stop time	1 hour & 45 minutes

## The ice will be re-surfaced as follows:

- Warm-ups will be 3 minutes in length.
- No flood for U11 teams between the 2nd and 3rd period, but a 2-minute break at the bench.
- **U13, U15, & U18 HL – flood between after the game OR every second period.**  
U13, U15, & U18 HL - flood every second period
- Overtime – after the first 10-minute overtime period in an elimination game, the ice will be resurfaced. It will then be resurfaced every second period.



# RULES & REGULATIONS

5. NOHA Tournament of Champions will be played under Official Hockey Canada, OHF, and NOHA Rules and Regulations.
6. Time-outs are allowed for all divisions of hockey in the NOHA. Each team shall be permitted to take one 30-second time-out during the course of regular playing time or overtime.
7. Team Representatives must declare the NOHA Team Roster in front of NOHA Representative at registration. Once the roster has been declared, it cannot be changed.
8. Affiliated players will be allowed among the Team's 20 players and must be declared at registration and appear on the team's HCR Roster.
  - If two affiliated teams play the same weekend, the names should be included at registration on the Hockey Canada Approved Roster Sheet. The only time they can use these affiliated players is when the lower team has finished their series.
9. If any player or team official is ordered to the dressing room for the balance of the game, they shall be subject to further disciplinary action as deemed necessary by the NOHA Representative.
10. Game Forfeit (as per OHF Regulation A6) – When a game is declared forfeited due to the non-appearance of the Team (Hockey Canada Rule 10.14d), the Team in attendance shall be declared the winner and the score recorded as 5-0. The incident shall be reported to the League / Association President to take any further actions as may be authorized in the organization's by-laws and regulations.
11. TIE BREAKING – **See Tie-Breaking Document.**
12. In the Semi-Final and Championship games, the Home team will be determined by the following:

<b>One Division</b>	Home Team is the highest placed in Preliminary Series
<b>Two Equal Divisions</b>	If two first-place Teams win Semi-Finals, then the two-Team tie breaking rule is used.
	If one Team won their Division and the other came second, the Team that won will be Home Team.
	If the Teams come from the same Division, then the First-Place Team will be Home.
<b>Seven or Nine Teams</b>	Coin Toss by NOHA Representative in presence of a representative from both Teams.



# RULES & REGULATIONS

13. The Semi-Final and Final games will be played until a Winner is declared. If at the end of regulation time the score is still tied, the teams shall take a two-minute rest at their benches and the following will then apply:

- 1.If the Referee feels it is necessary, they may order the ice to be cleaned at the end of the three regulation periods.
- 2.Teams shall not change ends.
- 3.The puck shall be faced off at centre ice and the play shall continue with a ten-minute sudden-victory overtime period.
- 4.If the score is still tied after the sudden-victory ten-minute period, the teams take normal break between periods and return to play sudden victory periods of normal length per division. They now change ends.
- 5.The ice will be resurfaced after the first 10-minute overtime period, then be resurfaced every second period.
- 6.Any overtime period is considered part of the game and all unexpired penalties remain in force.
- 7.If either team declines to play in the necessary overtime period(s), the game will be declared a loss for that team.
- 8.The NOHA Representative or their Appointee has the authority to render a decision under any emergency situation.

14. Teams will shake hands before the game.

15. Notwithstanding the provisions set forth in the NOHA, OHF, Hockey Canada Constitutions, By-Laws and Regulations, or the NOHA Tournament of Champions Rules and Regulations, the NOHA President or their designate may grant special dispensation from these Constitutions, By-Laws, and Regulations. Any decision as to what qualifies for special dispensation, shall rest solely with the NOHA President or their designate in its absolute unfettered discretion, and the decision based on its own merits of the situation on special dispensation shall be final and binding upon all parties.

## 16. Opening Ceremonies

1. Teams must be advised in advance and have the option of participating.
2. Participating players must be in full equipment.
3. Must be included on the approved schedule and should not exceed 15 minutes.

## 17. Closing Ceremonies

1. Officials remain on the ice.
2. Medals are presented to Teams.
3. The trophy is given to the winning Team and returned once they are finished.



# TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES

In the event of teams being tied at the end of the Round Robin series, for any position, the following procedure will be used to break a tie:

## TWO TEAMS:

- **a)** The team with the most wins will take the higher position.
- **b)** If still tied, the winner of the game(s) between those two teams will take the higher position.
- **c)** If still tied, the team with the best goal average will take the higher position. All Round Robin games are included.
- **d)** If still tied, the team that scored the first goal in the game involving both teams will take the higher position.
- **e)** If still tied, the team with the lowest number of penalty minutes during the Round Robin will take the higher position. (GM= 10 minutes, MP=15 minutes, GRM=10 minutes, Misconduct =10 minutes).
- **f)** If still tied, a coin toss will determine the higher position. The coin toss will be done by the NOHA Representative in the presence of a representative from each team. The NOHA Rep will assign which team is Heads or Tails.

## THREE to FIVE TEAMS:

- **aa)** The team with the most wins will take the higher position.
- **bb)** If still tied, the team with the higher percentage will take first, the rest placing in order.
- **cc)** If still tied, the team with the lowest number of penalty minutes during the Round Robin will take the higher position.
- **dd)** If still tied, a coin toss will determine the higher position. The coin toss will be done by the NOHA Representative in the presence of a representative from each team. The NOHA Rep will assign which team is Heads or Tails.
- **ee)** If 3 or more teams are still tied, then the NOHA Representative will place each team's name in a hat. The first team's name pulled will be the higher-placed team and so on.

## SIX TEAMS:

- **aaa)** The team with the most wins will take the higher position.
- **bbb)** If any of the tied teams have played each other the winner of the game will take the higher position. If they did not play each other then go to (ccc).
- **ccc)** The team with the higher percentage (1.0 being the highest attainable) will take the higher position as first place.
- **ddd)** The team with the second best goal average will take the higher position-as second place.
- **eee)** The team with the third best goal average will take the higher position-as third place
- **fff)** The team with the fourth best goal average will take the higher position-as fourth place.
- **ggg)** If still tied, the team who received the least number of penalty minutes during the Round Robin would take the higher position (GM=10 minutes, M= 10 minutes, MP=15 minutes, GRM= 15 minutes.)
- **hhh)** If 2 teams are still tied, have been applied, a coin toss will determine the higher position. The coin toss will be done by the NOHA Representative in the presence of a Representative from each Team. The NOHA Representative will assign which team is Heads or Tails.
- **iii)** If 3 or more teams are still tied, then the NOHA Representative will place the teams' names into a hat. The first team's name pulled will be the higher placed team and so on.
